### **Adult Guidance**

Please find below the reading comprehension questions and some handy talking points for your class after the children have read the minibook. These are designed to be adult-led and encourage discussion either one-to-one, in a small group or with the whole class.

#### 1. What is a pup?

Answer: A baby seal

#### Follow-up questions:

- · Are there any other animals whose babies are pups? Or puppies?
- · Do you know any other names of baby animals?
- · How do you think the adult seals look after their pups?

#### 2. What do you think a 'leader' is?

Answers might include: Someone who greets you. Someone to show you around. Someone who tells you about the animals. Someone who shows you the way. You follow the leader.

#### **Discussion points:**

- · What do you think a good leader should be like?
- · Can you think of a time when you have been a leader?

### 3. Can you think of 3 animals that are shorter than a shark?

Children to share their ideas.

#### **Discussion points:**

- Are there any animals that are bigger than a shark?
- · What do you think is the biggest sea creature?
- · How about the biggest land creature?
