What do you think the gnome wrote in the letter to Mrs Rabbit? Tell the person next to you.





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




4. How do you think Mrs Rabbit felt when her baby was lost?

5. Why did the gnome want to make a sign?

6. What do you think the sign said? Create your own sign below.





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Adult Guidance

Please find below the reading comprehension questions and some handy talking points for your class after the children have read the minibook. These are designed to be adult-led and encourage discussion either one-to-one, in a small group or with the whole class.

1. What were Kit and Sam doing in the park?

Answers may include: Helping to tidy it up; pruning the shrubs; going on a school trip

Follow-up questions:

- Who did they meet at the park?
- What plants or animals might you find in a park?
- What is a park-keeper and what do they do?

2. Where did the tunnel lead to?

Answer: The gnome's home

Follow-up questions:

- · What did the gnome's home look like?
- Why did the gnome need Kit and Sam's help?
- How did the rabbit get lost?

3. As Kit and Sam went along the tunnel they saw two things. What were they?

Answer: Gnarled roots and signs

Follow-up questions:

- What does the word 'gnarled' mean?
- What had caused the roots and signs to be 'gnarled'?
- What is Kit carrying along the tunnel?





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4. How do you think Mrs Rabbit felt when her baby was lost?

Answers might include: worried, sad, scared, anxious, upset, unhappy

Discussion points:

- Have you ever lost something?
- · How did you feel?
- If you lost something, how would you find it?

5. Why did the gnome want to make a sign?

Answers might include: To keep the gnats away; so the baby rabbit could play and not be scared; to stop the baby rabbit from getting lost.

Follow-up questions:

- What did the gnome make the sign out of?
- Where do you think he will put the sign?
- Do you think the sign will stop the gnats?

6. What do you think the sign said? Create your own sign below.

Answers might include: Keep away gnats! Don't come here gnats! Warning - baby rabbits playing! Don't scare the baby rabbits!

Discussion points:

- What is an exclamation mark? Can you use one on your sign?
- · How do you think the baby rabbit felt when they were reunited with their Mum?
- What might happen next in the story?
