Adult Guidance

Please find below the reading comprehension questions and some handy talking points for your class after the children have read the minibook. These are designed to be adult-led and encourage discussion either one-to-one, in a small group or with the whole class.

1. What did Mr Adams forget?

Answer: Some of the chords.

Follow-up questions:

- · What are chords?
- · What instrument was Mr Adams playing?
- · How do you think he felt forgetting the chords in front of the parents?
- If you could play a musical instrument, what would you choose?

2. How did Santa get to the fair?

Answer: With a parachute.

Discussion points:

- Do you think that's a better way for Santa to travel than his sleigh?
- · Where could he keep his presents?
- How would you feel if Santa landed in our playground one day?

3. Do you think Kit's plan of a chute to help Santa transport presents is a good one? Why do you think that?

The children can share their own opinion here. Encourage them to explain their thinking.

Discussion points:

- How do you think Santa gets all the presents to everyone in one night?
- Do you think you could make a machine to help him like Kit's chute? What would it look like?
- What could Kit use to make his chute?
