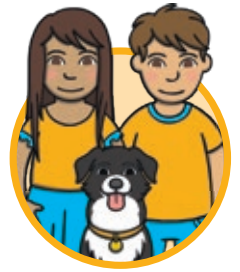


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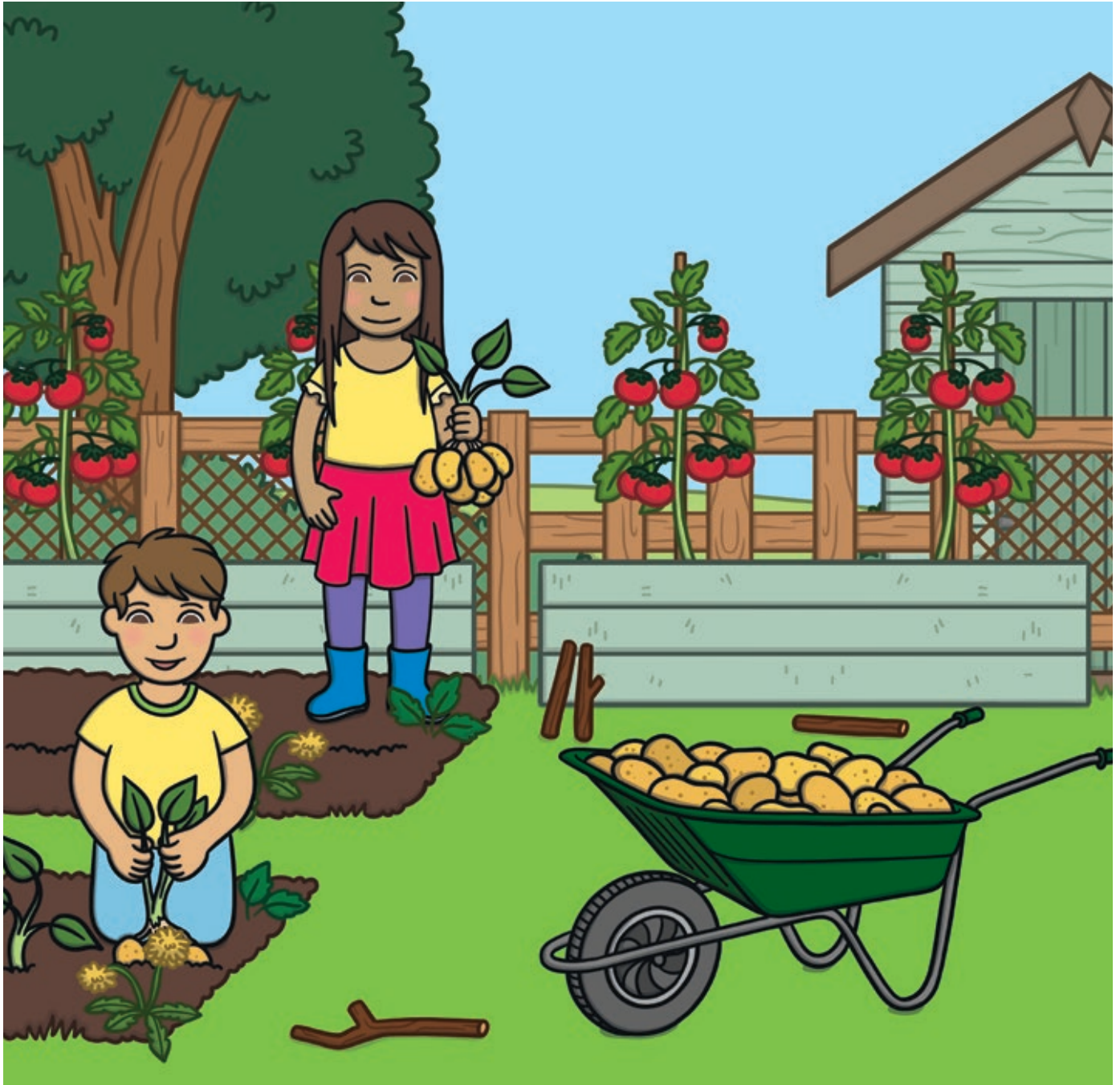
A Day at the Allotment

“**Please** stop!” cried Kit.



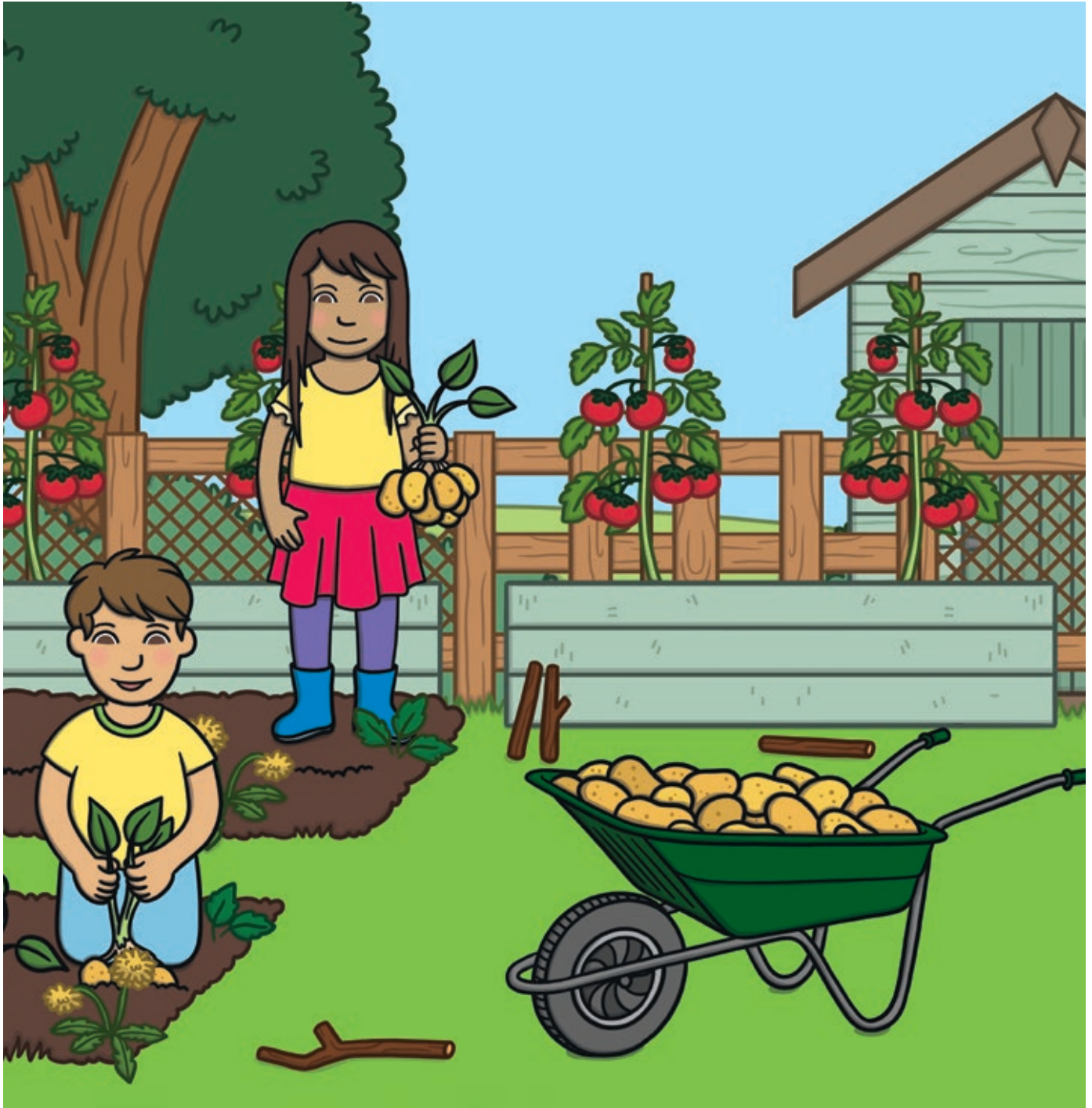
Kit had to pick the ripe tomatoes and put them in a bowl. **Once**, a tomato fell on the ground and got eaten by a greedy crow.
