
Careers Week








A 'Let's Read Together!' Book




Mrs West called an assembly and told us that it was Careers Week. We listened carefully and found out what it was about.




The following day, Gabi's Uncle Jack visits. He is a mountaineer and told us about the sheer drop on Mount Everest. The photos made my knees wobble!
